

❖ *Nature and Extent of involvement of Faculty and students in academic affairs/improvements*

The faculty and students are involved in academic affairs/improvements like curriculum development, course content preparation, involving in feedback system, and student's portfolio components.

Both faculty and students are identifying the lapses in academic activities and provides suggestions/guidelines for the development of academic affairs like co-curricular & extracurricular activities.

❖ *Mechanism/ Norms and Procedure for democratic/ good Governance*

**Mechanism/Norms and procedures for Good Governance**

Institute has a Decentralization mechanism for delegating authority and providing operational autonomy to all the various functionaries to work towards decentralized governance.

**Principal Level:**

The Governing Body delegates all the academic and operational decisions based on policy to the Academic Monitoring Committee headed by the Principal in order to fulfil the vision and mission of the institute.

**Deans level:**

Dean-Academics monitor all the academic activities through Academic Audit Committee which formulates common working procedures and entrusts the implementation with the departments and faculty members.

**Dean – R&D** monitors all R&D activities through department R&D coordinators.

**Dean – CSE** is nominated as Director-IQAC and monitors all IQAC functions.

**Faculty Level:**

Faculty members are given representation in various committees/cells and allowed to conduct various programs to showcase their abilities. They are encouraged to develop leadership skills by being in-charge of various academic, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities. They are given authority to conduct industrial tours and to have tie up with industry experts and appointed as coordinator and

convener for organizing seminars/workshops/conferences/FDPs. For effective implementation and improvement of the institute following committees are formed. Other units of the institute like sports, library, store etc. have operational autonomy under the guidance of the various committees/cells.

#### **Student Level:**

Students members are added in many of the committees mentioned above and these members take active roles in the respective committees.

#### **Participative management:**

The institute promotes a culture of participative management by involving the staff and students in various activities. All decisions of the institution are governed by proper objectives based on realistic information and facts. Both students and faculty are allowed to express themselves regarding any suggestions to improve the performance of the institute.

#### **Strategic Level:**

The principal, academic co-coordinator and staff members are involved in defining the policies and procedures, framing guidelines and rules & regulations pertaining to admission, placement, discipline, grievance, counselling, training & development, library services and effectively implementing the same to ensure smooth and systematic functioning of the institute. For the various programs to be conducted by the institute all the staff members will meet, discuss, share their opinion and plan for the event and form various committees involving students and coordinate with others. Staff members are regularly involved in deciding all academic activities conducted by the college.

#### **Functional Level:**

At functional level the faculty members participate in sharing the knowledge by discussing on the latest trends in technology during faculty meetings. Staff members are actively involved in implementing effective teaching-learning process and participate in assigned administrative responsibilities including budget proposals and utilization.

#### **Operational level:**

The principal of the institution is the member secretary of the Governing Body (GB).

The GB gives suggestions and monitors the procurement, introduction of new programs and welfare activities and all strategic plans.

The Principal of the institution is responsible for academic, non-academic and administrative activities of the institution. On behalf of the institution, he interacts and corresponds with all the organizations such as AICTE, PCI, Govt. of A.P, UGC and Affiliating University. The budget proposals for each department are prepared by the corresponding faculty members based on the department requirements regarding development, operational and maintenance. Office staffs are involved in executing day to day support services for both students and faculty.

**Activities conducted by CAB:**

- The Principal regularly conducts College Advisory Board (CAB) meeting to discuss various issues. All such issues are addressed by the Heads of the Departments with their faculty for implementing the decisions taken by CAB.
- Academic calendar is meticulously planned and prepared in advance by Dean-Academics office and CAB ensures the proper implementation of the academic calendar.
- CAB monitors the academic calendar and corresponding teaching-learning process and takes the appropriate decisions for effective implementation of curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities.
- CAB monitors the academic audit conducted every month and decides the corrective actions regarding teaching-learning process.
- All the agenda items on policies in CAB meetings are prepared by IQAC as per the strategic plans.

### ❖ **Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff and students**

In order to redress individual as well as collective grievances of the students and staff of the LBRCE, a grievance redressal mechanism has been devised. The LBRCE is having its own grievance Redressal system in an informal manner i.e through direct supervision of the principal and managing director earlier. But in formal sense along with the provision of suggestion boxes the grievance Redressal cell of the college was created on 2nd January 2012. The function of the cell is to look into the complaints lodged by any student, and judge its merit. The Grievance cell is also empowered to look into matters of harassment. Anyone with a genuine grievance may approach the department members in person, or in consultation with the officer in-charge Students' Grievance Cell. In case the person is unwilling to appear in self, grievances may be dropped in writing at the letterbox/ suggestion box of the Grievance Cell at Administrative Block.

The Grievances may broadly include the following complaints of the aggrieved students

- a. Academic
- b. Non-Academic
- c. Grievance related to Assessment
- d. Grievance related to Victimization
- e. Grievance related to Attendance
- f. Grievance related to charging of fees
- g. Grievance regarding conducting of Examinations
- h. Harassment by colleague students or the teachers etc.

There will be Grievance Redressal Committees at the Department/Institutes/central level to deal with the grievances of the students and staff.

**a. Department grievance committee** will be as under:

- i. Head of the Department - Chairman
- ii. Up to 3 (three) faculties to be nominated by the Head of Department This committee will deal with the Grievance related to Academic and Administrative matters of the Department.

**b. Institute Level Grievance Committee** will be as under:

- i. Senior faculty - Chairman
- ii. Up to 5 (five) senior faculties to be appointed by the Head of Institute as members This committee will deal with all the Grievances directly which is related to the common problems at Institute level both Academic and Administrative.

In addition, this committee will also entertain the appeal filed by the student against the decision of the Department level committee.

**c. CENTRAL GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE** will be as under:

- i. Director – Chairman
- ii. Principal
- iii. Convenor of the Faculty concerned
- iv. Head of Department concerned
- v. Senior professor.

This committee will deal with all the Grievances directly which is related to the common problems at institute level both Academic and Administrative. In addition, this committee will also entertain the appeal filed by student against the decision of the Institute level committee.

#### **Procedure for Redressal of Grievances**

- An aggrieved student who has the Grievance or Grievances at the Department level shall make an application first to the HOD. The Head of Department after verifying the facts will try to redress the grievance within a reasonable time, If the student is not satisfied with the verdict

or solution of the HOD, then the same should be placed before the Department level committee.

- If the student is not satisfied with the decision of Department committee, he/she can submit an appeal to the Institute level grievance committee within a week from the date of the receipt of the reply from the Department level committee. The convenor of Institute grievance committee, after verifying the facts and the papers concerned and having discussion within the Chairman of the Department committee will place the matter before the Institute level committee which shall either endorse the decision of the Department level committee or shall pass appropriate order in the best possible manner within a reasonable time.
- If the student is not satisfied with the Redressal offered by the Institute level committee and feel that his/her Grievance is not redressed, he/she can submit an appeal to the central grievance Redressal committee within a week from the date of receipt of decision with the relevant details.
- While dealing with the complaint the committee at all levels will observe law of natural justice and hear the complainant and concerned people. h. While passing an order on any Grievance at any level the relevant provisions of Act/Regulations should be kept in mind and no such order should be passed in contradiction of the same.
- The student will submit the application of Grievance or appeal to the Institute level committee or central grievance Redressal committee, as the case may be, through the Head of Department and Head of Institute concerned.

- The area of outdoor stadium is 8.58 acres, suitable for conducting even National level sports competitions. Athletic Track and facilities for field events like Javelin Throw, Shot-put, Discus-Throw and Jumps are made available in this outdoor stadium.
- Usually the sports and games facilities are utilized by the students outside the academic hours.
- An Indoor stadium of size 30m x 40m x 12m is made available with gallery to accommodate 500 spectators. In this stadium Badminton courts and Gymnastic facilities are made available.
- Another 24 station modern Gymnasium with treadmill facility as well as weight lifting facility is also made available. Separate timings are made available specifically for girl students in the same Gymnasium.

- 11) Continuous inputs from all stakeholders are taken to improve the curriculum on regular basis.
- 12) Professional ethics course has been introduced in the curriculum
- 13) Additional Training on communication skills and soft skills is further increased.
- 14) Research aptitude among the students is inculcated through project implementations.
- 15) An Advisory Committee has been formulated for every department with suitable external members.
- 16) A regular monitoring of Academic growth is taken care by the College Advisory Board (CAB)

- 17) Membership in various professional bodies like IEEE, CSI, ISTE, IE, IETE, ISHRE is improved.
- 18) Institute has signed some MOUs and established collaborations with reputed organizations and institutions
- 19) Participation of students in Sports, NCC, NSS activities as well as cultural events is considered as mandatory in R23 regulations.
