6. Outcomes of the Programme

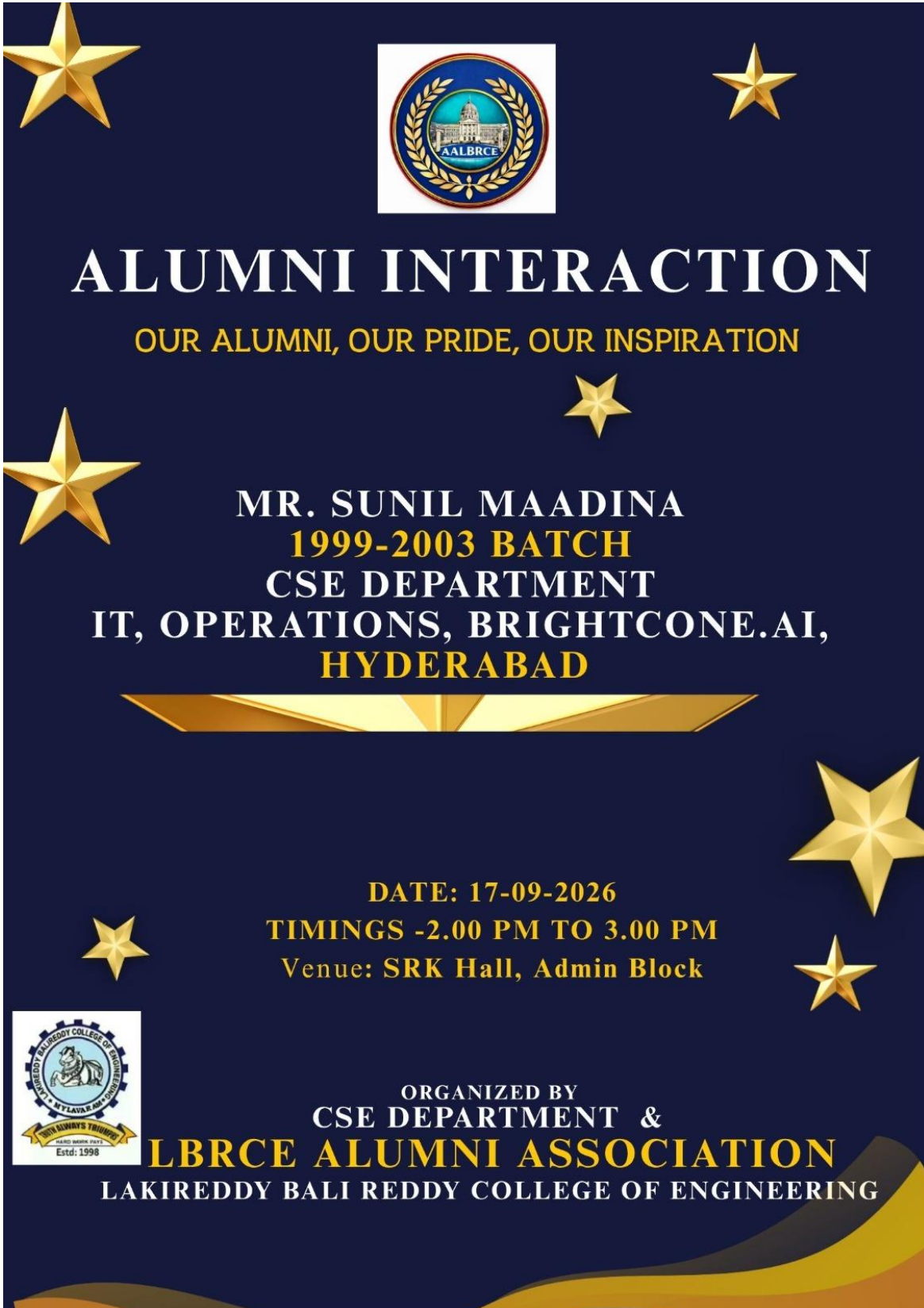
- Students gained a better understanding of industry expectations and professional career preparation.

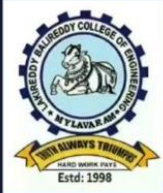
