REPORT

World Water Day, observed on the 22nd March each year, is intended to raise awareness about water-related issues and encourage people to take action to address global water challenges. The theme for the year is announced by the United Nations as "Water for Peace".

The World Water Day-2024 is celebrated at LBRCE in association with IE (I) AP State Centre, Vijayawada on 22nd March 2024. The Civil Engineering Department of LBRCE organized the programme. A Guest lecture by Sri P.L.N. Kartic, Superintending Engineer, Capital Region Development Authority, Vijayawada is arranged on this occasion, who acted as the Chief Guest and Key note speaker. This programme is arranged for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year B.Tech Civil students of LBRCE.

In his address, Sri Kartic highlighted the various sources of water, their quality problems, and the need to purify the water. He stressed on water conservation, ground water recharge and water minimization aspects to handle the water crisis that is being faced by the world today. He introduced few case studies of global water crisis, in particular, the problems faced in Bangalore. He discussed the solutions to address the problems faced by the cities where they have become concrete jungles with little space for groundwater recharge. He advised few tips to conserve water in the day-to-day life to the audience.
