Description / Report on Event: As part of the observance of **World Ozone Day 2026**, a **Poster Presentation Competition** was organized with the aim of creating awareness among students about the importance of the ozone layer, the threats posed by ozone-depleting substances, and the need for sustainable cooling practices. The event focused on the theme “**Global Action for a Cooler Planet – Celebrating 10 Years of Sustainable Cooling under the Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol.**” The theme highlights the importance of global action for protecting the ozone layer while addressing climate change through sustainable and energy-efficient cooling solutions.
