1. Objective of the Event

Description of the event :

Day 1: 13-08-2026

- Workshop was inaugurated on 13/08/2026 by Dr S.Nagarjuna Reddy, HOD – CSE, Convener(s) of the workshop, along with Dr. M. Srinivasa Rao, Dean of Academics & Dr.D.Sai Satish Resource Person, Indian Servers, Vijayawada.

- Gain hands-on experience with cybersecurity tools and techniques used for identifying, analysing, and mitigating security threats.
- Participate in a Capture the Flag (CTF) challenge designed to test problem-solving skills and practical cybersecurity knowledge.
- Learn the fundamentals of incident detection and response and understand how organizations defend against cyber-attacks.
- Apply defensive security practices to strengthen systems, protect sensitive information, and minimize potential cyber risks.
