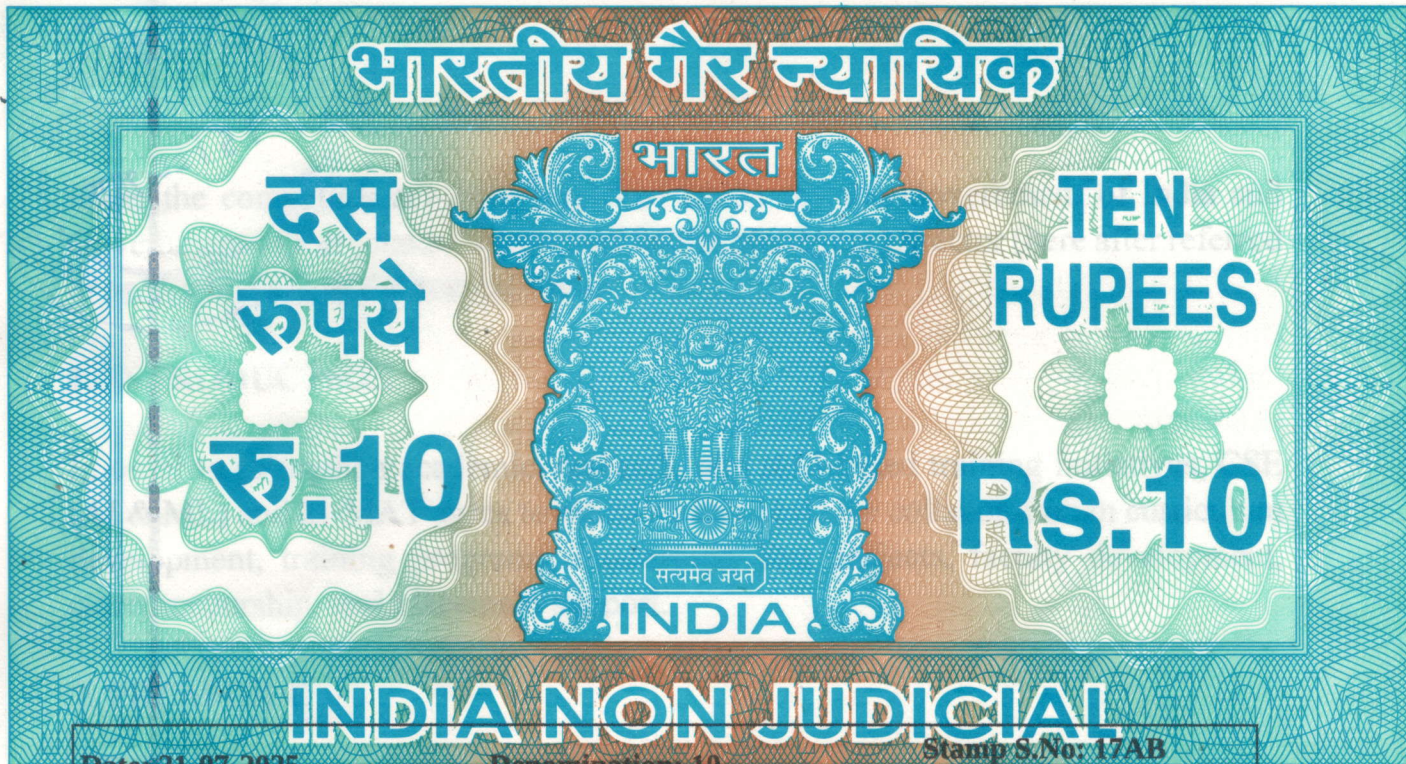

1. INTRODUCTION

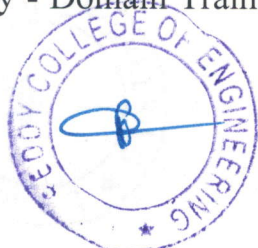
In order to strengthen academic, research, and skill-based training initiatives, CSE (AI & ML) and Li-MAT agree to establish this MoU for collaboration in curriculum development, training programs, internships, live projects, faculty development, entrepreneurship, and placement support.

2. PREAMBLE

Lakireddy Bali Reddy College of Engineering (LBRCE) was established in 1998 by the Lakireddy Bali Reddy Charitable Trust with the vision of promoting value-based technical education. The College has been granted autonomous status by UGC since 2010 and is recognized under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956. Accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade and several programs accredited under NBA (Tier-I), LBRCE has consistently focused on academic excellence. LBRCE has also been recognized as a “College with Potential for Excellence (CPE)” by UGC. The institution offers ten undergraduate B.Tech programs, four postgraduate M.Tech and MBA programs.

The CSE (AI & ML) Department, established in 2021, follows a semester system with rigorous internal and external evaluations, and the faculty actively engage in research and projects in domains such as Advancement in Artificial Intelligence like Generative AI, LLM and Cyber Security.

Li-MAT was founded on 26th Feb-2020 as a Software Development, Ed-Tech and Digital Marketing Services recognized company duly registered company under the companies act 2013(No.18 of 2013) head quartered in Bengaluru, Karnataka. Its core mission is to bridge the skill gap between academia and industry by providing comprehensive upskilling programs. Li-MAT offers industry-aligned training in domains such as AI & ML, Full Stack Development, Data Analytics, Digital Marketing, UI/UX Design, Healthcare IT, and Data Science, integrating theoretical knowledge with live work experience. The company follows a three-stage learning methodology - Domain Training, Skill Development, and Live Work Experience -



aimed at enhancing employability, practical skills, and industry readiness.

This MoU is intended to leverage the strengths of CSE (AI & ML) , LBRCE in academic excellence, industry-oriented skill development, fostering collaboration in areas such as academic and research programs, Business Analytics projects, student internships, faculty development, entrepreneurship initiatives, and placement support in collaboration with Li-MAT. The partnership will promote mutual growth, innovation, and societal impact through joint programs and projects while adhering to the academic and operational norms of both institutions.

3. THE SCOPE OF MOU

The collaboration between CSM, LBRCE and Li-MAT will include the following:

- a) Industry-relevant modules are integrated with advancement in AI into existing academic programs at LBRCE.
- b) Conduct workshops, short-term training programs, and seminars for students and faculty.
- c) Provide hands-on training in Artificial Intelligence, Cloud, Machine Learning, Python, Full-stack Java, and other relevant tools.
- d) Facilitate student internships at Li-MAT.
- e) Offer final-year and capstone projects under joint mentorship of CSM faculty and company professionals.
- f) Provide exposure to real-world Business Analytics and digital projects.
- g) Support to Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) to update faculty on emerging trends and technologies in Advancement in technology with constrain of 2 resource persons as free of cost.
- h) Enable joint guidance and mentoring for student projects.



- i) Provide mentorship to students to develop entrepreneurial skills or industry readiness.
- j) Support initiatives for startups, franchising, and innovation projects in AI, ML and digital domains.
- k) Assist students in career development and facilitate placement opportunities in IT sectors a minimum of 5 to 10 skilled students from any branch from the LBRCE.
- l) Conduct mock interviews, skill assessments, and resume-building workshops.
- m) Maintain confidentiality of proprietary information exchanged during the collaboration.
- n) Ensure compliance with relevant data protection and privacy regulations.

4. STUDENT ENGAGEMENT AND FACULTY DEVELOPMENT

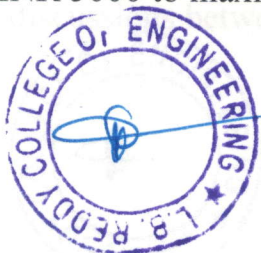
Students of LBRCE may participate in Li-MAT training programs, including projects and practical exposure in Industry oriented Skills. They may also engage in live projects, internships, or final-year projects under the joint mentorship of CSM faculty and company professionals.

- Faculty of CSM may undergo training, mentoring, and project guidance at Li-MAT to enhance their expertise across these domains.
- Professionals from Li-MAT may organize Guest lectures, workshops, and Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) with commercial.

Both parties will collaborate in research and project supervision for students and faculty in Latest Technologies.

5. FINANCIAL INVOLVEMENT

- a) All financial aspects of joint activities under this MoU shall be mutually agreed upon on a project-to-project or activity-to-activity basis's should be approximate of minimum INR 5000 to maximum INR 10000 per student.



b) The Training offered by Li-MAT shall provide support for training programs, workshops, internships, live projects, and faculty development initiatives.

c) Any cost-sharing or financial commitments will be documented in writing prior to the commencement of each activity.

d) Financial arrangements shall ensure transparency, accountability, and effective utilization of resources with accommodation.

6. MoU MODALITIES

This MoU shall become effective immediately upon signing by both parties and shall remain valid for a period of **One (1)** year from the date of execution. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing one (1) months' written notice in advance. In the event of termination, for any reason, both parties agree to complete all ongoing joint projects, conferences, student internships, and faculty development activities during the notice period and ensure a smooth transition of responsibilities.

7. MOU MODIFICATION OR AMENDMENT

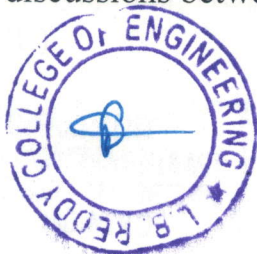
Any article or clause of this MoU may be modified, removed, or amended with the mutual consent of both CSM and Li-MAT. The MoU may be reviewed and revised at any time if both parties agree that such changes are necessary to better implement the objectives of the collaboration.

8. SEPARATE AGREEMENTS

Each activity outlined in this MoU shall be governed by mutually agreed terms and conditions. If required, both parties may enter into additional case-specific agreements or amend any clause of this MoU through mutual negotiation and consent to facilitate specific projects or activities.

9. ARBITRATION

Any dispute arising out of or relating to this MoU shall first be addressed through good-faith discussions between the appropriate authorities of CSM and Li-MAT.



If the dispute is not resolved within one (1) months, an arbitrator, mutually appointed by both parties, shall resolve the matter in accordance with applicable Indian laws.

10. GENERAL

All activities conducted under this MoU shall adhere to and respect the norms, rules, and regulations of both collaborating parties. Both parties hereby agree to execute this MoU within the scope and framework outlined herein, ensuring effective collaboration and fulfilment of the objectives stated.
