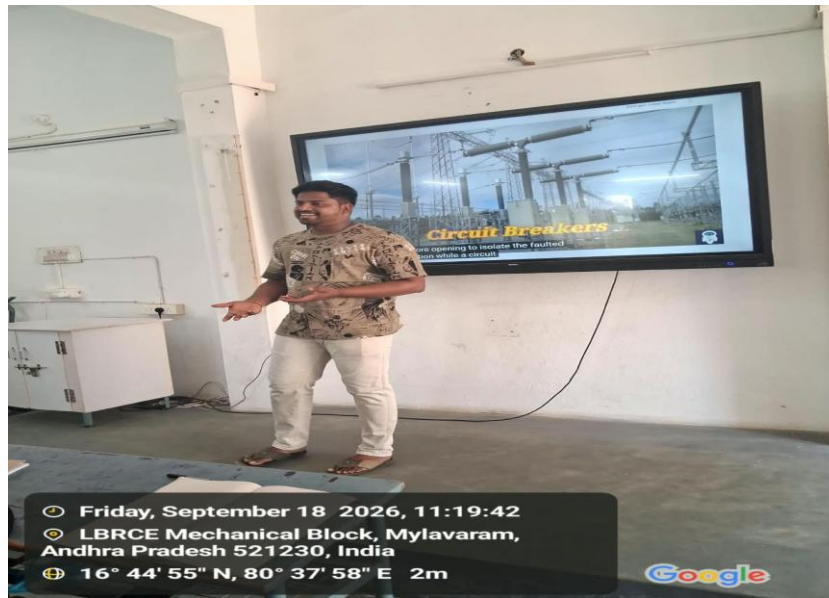
Outcome
